1. A book with one author

Author's Last name, Initials. (Year of publication). *Title of book: Capital letter also for subtitle.* Publisher.

Berry, J. (2019). *Lovely war.* Penguin Random House.

2. A book with more than one author

Author's Last name, Initials. & Author's Last name, Initials. (Year of publication). *Title of book: Capital letter also for subtitle.* Publisher.

Hickman, P., & Fukawa, M. (2011). *Japanese Canadian internment in the Second World War.* James Lorimer and Co.

3. A website

Author's Last name, Initials OR Organization. (Year, Month Date of publication). *Title of article.* Source (omit this if it's the same as author/organization). URL

Royal Society of Chemistry. (2017). *Periodic Table.* <http://www.rsc.org/periodic-table>

4. An online image

Title or Description of the image. From "Title of web page," by Author/Creator's First initial. Second initial. Last name, Publication date, *Title of Website.* Retrieved Month, day, year you last viewed the website, from URL. Copyright date by Name of Copyright Holder.

5. A video

Person or group who uploaded video. (Date of publication). *Title of video* [Video]. Website host. URL

Graham, A. et al. (2013, Aug 15). *Día de los muertos* [Video]. Youtube. <http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=jCQnUuq-TEE>

6. A journal article from a database (e.g. Google Scholar, Gale, EBSCO)

Author, A. A., & Author, B. B. (Year of publication). Title of article. *Title of Journal*, volume number(issue number), page range. URL
